In an effort to get you ready to start at Thayer School we're sending you this Check List/Information Sheet. Our hope is that it will be easier for you to have all this information together rather than receiving separate mailings for each item.

- **Dartmouth Email Account-** A Dartmouth email account has been created for you. Enclosed is a mailer for those who do not already have a Dartmouth email account with your password and login instructions. We strongly recommend that you change your password (you can do so from the web email application). For more information about computing at Thayer School please go to http://help.thayer.dartmouth.edu/index.php/Main_Page. **Please monitor/use your Dartmouth email account – we will use this account to send information over the summer.**
- **Final Transcript-** Before the start of Fall term, please mail your final transcript to Thayer School's Registrar Daryl Laware. Her mailing address is 8000 Cummings Hall, Hanover, NH 03755.
- **Health Services –** By now you should have received an information packet from the Health Services Office. (If not, please contact Ginger Lawrence at ginger.lawrence@dartmouth.edu.) - **Billing/DPay -** D-Pay provides online access to account statements and, if you choose, online payment. Account holders can also provide access to "Other Payers".
