BE “Application” Process

We are pleased that you have decided to continue on at Dartmouth by becoming a Bachelor of Engineering student at Thayer School. Below are a few steps that should simplify the process for you.

1. Completely fill out the Student Information Form (aka BE Application Form) and the Bachelor of Engineering Program Form (available online through BannerStudent).
2. Once you have these forms filled out, discuss your program plan with your advisor (or any Thayer School faculty member in your area of interest) and have him/her sign your program form. To specify a three-course concentration in Section D, see the sample programs in the Thayer Bulletin and discuss choice of courses with your advisor.
3. Turn in your BE Program form, along with your Student Information Form to the Thayer School Academic and Student Affairs Office (M103 MacLean). Your program will be reviewed by the BE Program Committee before final approval by the BE Program Director.
