

GRADUATE COURSE EQUIVALENCE AND CREDIT

Graduate courses taken previously, either at Dartmouth College or at another institution, may be used to satisfy Thayer graduate degree requirements. Consult the appropriate graduate program description in the Guide to Programs and Courses to determine how prior course credit will affect your degree requirements.

If credit is requested for a Thayer School equivalent course, the Thayer professor who will be teaching the course during the current academic year, or who most recently taught the course if it is not offered this academic year, must approve the course equivalence.

If credit is requested for a previous graduate course for which a Thayer equivalent does not exist, for example, a specialty course, either the student's research adviser or the appropriate Thayer graduate program director (BE/MEM or MS/PhD) must approve the course credit.

NOTE: FOR MASTER'S AND DOCTORAL STUDENTS, TRANSFER COURSES MUST BE GRADUATE LEVEL AND NOT USED TO SATISFY BACHELOR'S DEGREE REQUIREMENTS.
